Definitions:

You can tick several of these on the declaration.

Assistance dog (GEN):

Refers to basic assistance dog work including working in public, and performing tasks which do not rely on the physical structure of the dog (including psychiatric tasks, deep pressure therapy, behaviour interruptions, medical alerts, medical response, and more.)

Assistance dog (LM):

Refers to assistance dog work which relies on the dog's structure, not including weight bearing tasks. (item retrieval, take downs, crowd control, blocking)

Assistance dog (HM):

Refers to assistance dog work which relies on the dog's structure, specifically weight bearing tasks. (Counterbalance, bracing, and more). **All dogs cleared for HM should undergo relevant health testing including hip and elbow x-rays and should be at least 2 years of age.**

Assistance dog (G):

Refers to assistance dog work, specifically guiding with the use of a proper guide harness.
